Principle:

Pain is subjective experience, not always associated with nociception. Pain is distinguished as two types, peripheral or neurogenic pain, may involve the following pathological states: peripheral nociceptive afferent neurons which are activated by noxious stimuli and central mechanism which is activated



by afferent inputs. The centrally acting analgesics generally elevate the pain threshold of mice towards heat. Hot plate and tail flick tests are most sensitive methods to centrally acting analgesics.
