- ❖ R & D cell promotes students to work on minor problem-based research project and present/ publish outcomes in national/ international conferences/ journals of repute.



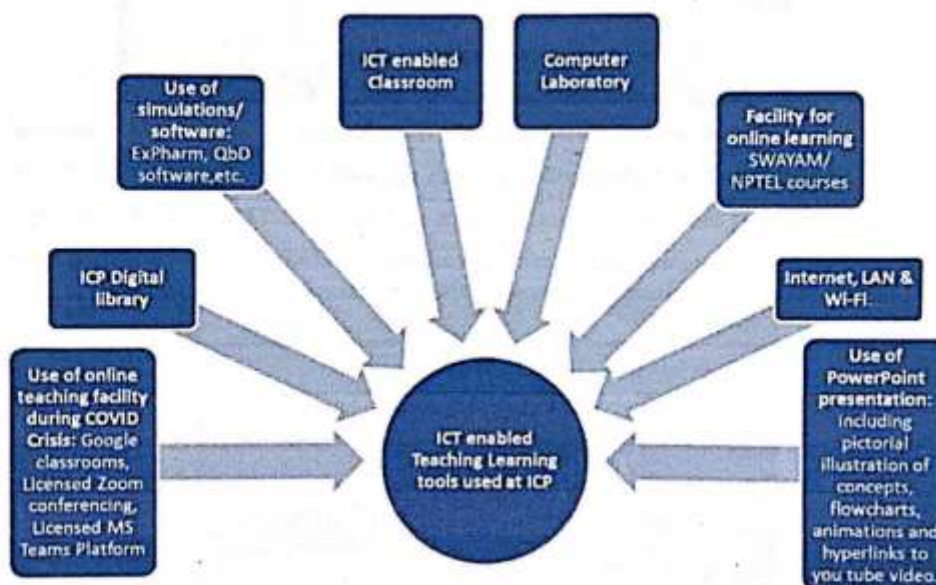

Determination of Hemoglobin.

Aim :- To determine the Hemoglobin content of your own blood sample.

Requirements :-

- 1) Sahli hemoglobinometer :- It consists of
a) A standard brown glass mounted on a comparator.
b) A graduated tube, c) Hb-Pipette (0.02 ml).
- 2) 0.1 N Hydrochloric acid.
- 3) Distilled water.
- 4) Pasteur Pipette.

Principle :- When blood is added to 0.1 N Hydrochloric acid, hemoglobin is converted to brown colored acid hematin. The resulting colour after dilution is compared with standard brown glass reference blocks of a Sahli's Hemoglobinometer.

Procedure :-

- 1) By using a Pasteur pipette add 0.1 N hydrochloric acid in the tube up to the lowest mark (20% mark).
- 2) Draw blood up to 20 ul mark in the Hb-pipette. Adjust the blood column, carefully without bubbles. Wipe excess of blood on the

Aim : To study introduction & demonstration of high performance liquid chromatography.

Introduction :

Chromatography can be based as mass transfer process involving adsorption using a non-polar stationary phase & a mobile polar phase traveling through the column. The active component of the column, the adsorbent or the stationary phase, is typically a granular material made of solid particles 2-50 μm in size. The component of sample mix. are separated from each other by means mobile phase & different degree of interactions with the sorbent particles based on their relative polarity.









High performance liquid chromatography (HPLC) is a chromatographic technique used to separate a mix. of comp. in analytical chemistry & biochemistry with the purpose of identify, quantify or purifying the individual component of mix. Before the invention of HPLC, chemists has column chromatography at their disposal & column chromatography was time consuming. The basic setup of a classic column chromatography was time consuming. The basic setup of a classic column chromatography would include the column that varied in ID from 10 to 50 mm & column length of 50-500 cm. The column was then packed with the stationary phase ranging in particle size from 150-200 μm thick.

Experiment-2

Aim: To determine molarity and content of given sample of acid (HCl) using strong base (NaOH) by potentiometric titration.

Requirements:-
 Apparatus: Volumetric flask, beaker, stirrer, potentiometer, burette, conical flask, water bath.
 Chemicals: 0.1M NaOH, 0.1M HCl, phenolphthalein.

Principle:-
 In this titration potentiometric titration methods are used. In this method, the potential of a suitable indicator electrode is convenient for determining the equivalence point for titration. It provides different information than does a direct Potentiometric measurement. It provides more accurate data than classical method.

In this method, strong acid and strong base is used when strong acid (conc. HCl) and strong base (NaOH) react together, then HCl dissociates and forms H^+ + Cl^- ions. When NaOH dissociates it forms Na^+ + OH^- ions. When NaOH is added to HCl, Na^+ ions combine with Cl^- ions to form NaCl and OH^- ions and H^+ ions combines to form (H_2O) water molecules.

This reaction is a neutralisation reaction. The direct measurement technique requires single emf reading on the sample solution. In this method of standard addition, the concentration of specific ion sample is

EXPERIMENT - 2

Aim: To prepare and sterilize nutrient agar and Sabouraud agar.

Requirements:

CHEMICALS: Beef extract, peptone, glucose, sodium chloride, agar.

APPARATUS: Conical flask, glass rod, burner, Petri plate, test tube measuring cylinder, cotton.

EQUIPMENT: Autoclave, oven, pH meter, balance.

Principle:

Nutrient agar is nutrient broth solidified by the addition of 1 to 2 % agar. In addition to liquid media, solid and semi-solid media are widely used for cultivation of bacteria. Solid media are useful for isolating bacteria or for determining the characteristics of colonies. Semisolid media are prepared with agar at concentrations of 0.5% or less are useful for the cultivation of microaerophilic bacteria and for detection of bacterial motility. Sabouraud agar media are routinely used for isolation and maintenance of common fungi. Composition of nutrient agar and sabouraud agar are as follows.

i) Nutrient Agar

by afferent inputs. The centrally acting analgesics generally elevate the pain threshold of mice towards heat. Hot plate and tail flick tests are most sensitive methods to centrally acting analgesics.
