#### 5. Plastic free environment drive

Plastic pollution is the accumulation of plastic objects and particles in the Earth's environment that adversely affects humans, wildlife and their habitat. Plastics are inexpensive and durable, making them very adaptable for different uses; as a result, manufacturers choose to use plastic over other materials. However, the chemical structure of most plastics renders them resistant to many natural processes of degradation and as a result they are slow to degrade. This causes plastic waste and hazard to the environment. Students learnt about recycling of plastic waste, segregation of plastic material and created awareness about it.

#### 6. Pulse Polio campaign

Pulse Polio is an immunisation campaign established by the government of India to eliminate poliomyelitis (polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus. The project fights polio through a large-scale, pulse vaccination programme and monitoring for poliomyelitis cases. Pulse Polio Immunization (PPI) aims at covering every individual in the country. It aspires to reach even children in remote communities through an improved social mobilisation plan. 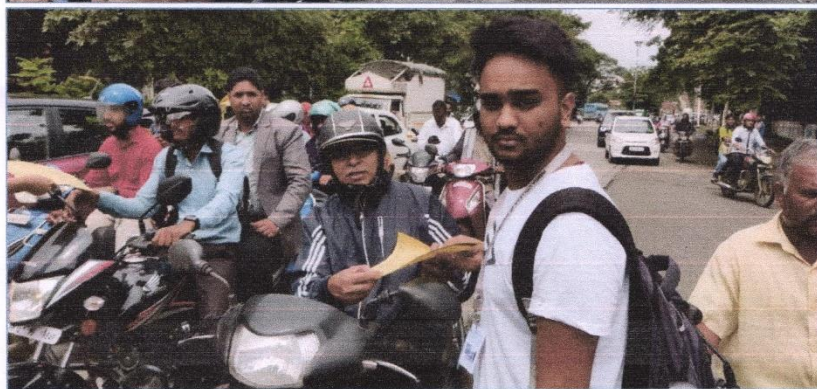

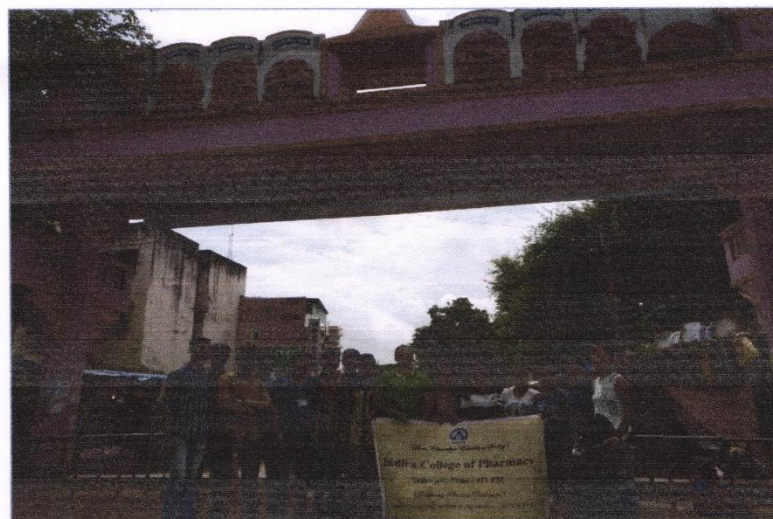

### Extension Activities 2020-21

#### 1. Health check-up camp for Police personnel

SCES's Indira college of Pharmacy, Pune organized a free health check-up camp for the police in October 2020. More than 35 police officers as well as female constables from nearby police stations got their health check-up done at the medical camp. The attendees were tested for any signs of cough, cold, flu like symptoms. They were also tested for hypertension and bone related problems.

Through community awareness program, dengue awareness was created by students and faculty members of ICP. People were educated on use of insect repellent and maintaining cleanliness & hygiene of surroundings.

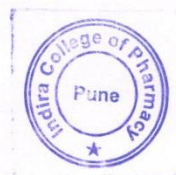

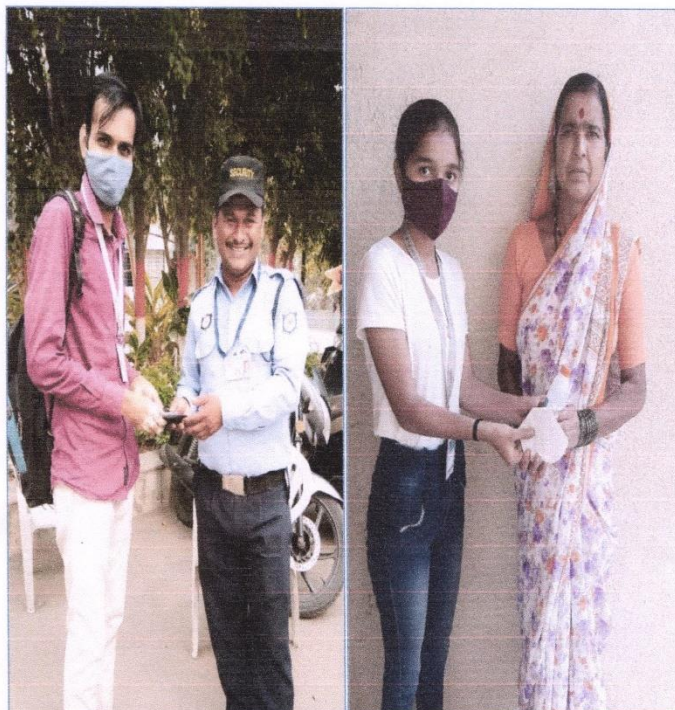

### Extension Activities 2021-22

#### 1. Polio Campaign

The Pulse Polio was started with the global initiative of eradication of polio: Pulse Polio Immunization programme was launched in India in 1995. Hence every year vaccination is provided to all children under the age of five years to fight polio. Contributing in this social national drive students of ICP volunteered for it. In a weeks time, they went door to door and administered oral polio drops. They ensured that children under five years got the dose.

#### 2. Tree plantation & nurturing drive

Indira college of Pharmacy's NSS cell organized, a "TREE PLANTATION DRIVE" with active participation of faculty members. The students along with their teachers visited places near Lavale in Mulshi Taluka and carried out extensive tree plantation. They planted trees beneficial to the environment like Neem, Babul, Mango, Eucalyptus, Gulmohar and Amla. Cleaning the area, digging pits and planting the saplings was done with great enthusiasm by students.

#### 3. Blood Donation Camp
