





The NSS unit of ICP college along with the Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation, in wake of World Pharmacist Day under National Immunization Drive, participated in a pulse polio campaign conducted between 29th January – 2nd February 2018. Mr. Shrinwas Patil Sir was the coordinator for the drive.

Pulse Polio is an immunisation campaign established by the government of India to eliminate poliomyelitis (polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus. The project fights polio through a large-scale, pulse vaccination programme and monitoring for poliomyelitis cases. Pulse Polio Immunization (PPI) aims at covering every individual in the country. It aspires to reach even children in remote communities through an improved social mobilization plan. The drive aims – "Not a single child should miss the immunization and leaving no chance of polio occurrence". Young students from our pharma courses actively participate and volunteer for such drives. ICP group of students were assigned different areas and assigned the task of going door-to-door, check for kids below five years and administer them the oral drops. Our students understood the importance of timely vaccine administration and my meeting people of different strata during the drive became matured and sensible. During the drive the students understood the value of time as they had to adjust their academics and duties for the drive simultaneously. The drive also taught them delegation of work and to work as a team. Total number of students that participated in the drive were 50.

Pulse Polio is an immunisation campaign established by the government of India to eliminate poliomyelitis (polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus. The project fights polio through a large-scale, pulse vaccination programme and monitoring for poliomyelitis cases. Pulse Polio Immunization (PPI) aims at covering every individual in the country. It aspires to reach even children in remote communities through an improved social mobilisation plan. The drive aims – "Not a single child should miss the immunization and leaving no chance of polio occurrence". Young students from our pharma courses (60 in number) actively participated and volunteered for the drive. ICP group of students were assigned different areas and assigned the task of going door-to-door, check for kids below five years and administer them the oral drops. Our students understood the importance of timely vaccine administration and my meeting people of different strata during the drive became matured and sensible.
