A report of the faculty development programme on theme 'Train the Trainer'

A faculty development programme on theme Train the Trainer' was Organised by SCES'S Indira College of Pharmacy in collaboration with Association of Pharmaceutical Teachers of India- Maharashtra state Women's Forum from 2nd May to 4th May 2023. The program was organised with objective of updating the pharmacy teachers on the latest developments and advancements in the field of pharmaceutical science, technology, and research. The faculty development programme was organised in online mode.

On day 1 (Tuesday; 2nd May 2023), Session I was delivered by Dr. Parizad Elchidana, Pricnipal. She is a technical consultant Pharma at ACG. Her topic was "Artificial intelligence (AI) & machine learning (ML) in Pharma industry". She explained that Over the past decade, how artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML) have become the breakthrough technology most anticipated to have a transformative effect on pharmaceutical research and development (R&D). Session II was delivered by Dr. Arati Prabhu, Associate Professor, Dr. Bhanuben Nanavati College of Pharmacy, Mumbai. She delivered a talk on topic "Computer Aided drug design 3D therapeutic thinking". In her talk she discussed that Computer-aided drug design (CADD) techniques minimise the time and cost burdens associated with drug research and development by ensuring an advantageous starting point for pre-clinical and clinical assessments.

On day 2 (Wednesday, 3rd May 2023) Session I was delivered by Dr. Rukhsana Rub. She is associated with AAEMF's Delight College of Pharmacy, Koregaon Bhima. Pune as Professor and Principal. She explained about "A Conventional and innovative pedagogy for empowerment of new age Faculty: Need for Pharmacognosy facelift". Dr Rukhsana discussed

on Innovation in education encourages students and demands teachers to be proactive to research, explore, and use multiple strategies to come out with novel ideas or a strategy to uncover something new. Session II was delivered by Dr. Suneela Dhaneshwar, Professor, Director and Deputy Dean of Research, Amity University, Lucknow. She discussed and elaborated about "Scientific writing and Plagiarism". She explained on the fundamental concepts in drafting a scientific manuscript to effectively communicate research findings. Further she also given overview of the steps and principals involved in organizing a manuscript logically and sequentially within a structure. I

On day 3 (Thursday, 4th May 2023), Session I was delivered by Dr. Indu Pal Kaur, Professor, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Punjab University. She discussed and elaborated about "My experiences and life lesson in translational research". With her vast experienced she explain the translational research in lucid language. Session II was delivered by Dr. Anuradha Majumdar, Associate Professor, Bombay College of Pharmacy, Kalina Santacruz (E) Mumbai. She delivered session on "Integrating Network pharmacology as a vital tool in bioinformatics: A deviceful approach in drug discovery". She mentioned that the Network pharmacology is an integrative in silico approach for establishing a "proteincompound/disease—gene" network to reveal the mechanisms underlying the synergistic therapeutic actions of traditional medicines.

The FDP addressed the issue like improving the classroom delivery, scientific writing, and conducting meaningful research.


