

- ✓ In case of medical leave, on joining student must furnish medical certificate and details of treatment.
- ✓ Leave for any purpose has to be sanctioned in advance by Class teacher and Principal.
- ✓ College Fees should be paid every year before 15th July.
- Each student can issue 2 books on one card for a period of 10 days.
- ✓ Late fees of Rs.2 will charged per book pre day.
- ✓ A new I-card can be issued by paying a fine of Rs.100 in the accounts department and submitting the receipt of the same to the librarian, if it is lost.
- Students should carry their Identity cards at all times and wear decent, formal attire.
- ✓ Use of Mobile phones and other gadgets is not permitted in the college, during instructional hours.
- ✓ Students shall be given home assignments by the respective teachers which is as an integral part of academics.

- Ragging is a crime and a strict disciplinary action will be taken as per the law.
- Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 which is in effect from 15th May, 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging:
- Ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited.
- Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty, which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Objective of Anti Ragging Committee




Introduction

When India became independent, it committed itself to a socially just and equal social order. The Constitution of the country, promulgated in 1950, recognizes the scheduled castes and the scheduled tribes as the two most backward groups needing special protection A number of provisions have been made in the Constitution with a view to abolish all forms of discrimination and put these groups at par with others. Specific provisions for the reservation in services, in favour of the members of the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, have been made in the Constitution of India. The main objective of providing reservation for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Government services is not just to give jobs to some persons belonging to these communities, and thereby increase their representations in the services, but to improve the status of these people socially and educationally so that they can take their rightful place in the mainstream of society.




Mechanism

- On receiving a complaint, the Committee shall call a meeting within 7 days of receipt of complaint
- Committee should address the issue related to discrimination
- The committee should arrange a Hearing to investigate the issue.
- Make Report of the issue with proper investigationremarks
- Action taken or dismissal of case both should be informed to the concerns.
- Resolution of the issue within 15 days.






